



Ocker Craft Retreats:

Please let Dianne Psencik or Lisa Sebek know if you are interested in the Ocker Craft Retreats. These retreats began about 12 years ago and have been a great fundraising resource for the entities that host them. There is quite a bit of planning and organization each quarter. However, the retreat averages \$2,500 to the hosting organization which provides around \$10,000 annually to church organizations. The retreats are a great outreach and we have had several join the church since beginning these retreats. Preparations include: a mailout announcing the retreat to our mailing list, receiving RSVP's and retreat fees, set up of Faith Hall, take down and cleanup afterwards to include vacuuming and taking out the trash; planning and preparation of meals to include some dish washing, door prizes for the 3 meal times and a devotional that is always included at these retreats. Meals provided are: Friday evening, Saturday morning Kolaches, Saturday noon meal and Saturday evening meal. The ladies (and sometimes men) love the craft retreats and the meals we provide to them.
